Please contact the Nazareth School office 619-641-7987 or office@nazarethschool.org. According to the HHSA, any person with these symptoms must self-isolate for 10 days (stay at home) and may return on day 11.

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (fever defined as a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit that does not resolve within 30 minutes without medication)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Nasal Congestion or runny nose (rhinorrhea)
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor feeding or poor appetite
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

Renaissance/STAR Testing will begin next week and it will be completed in the exact same process as in the Winter.

- In-Person learners will take the STAR Testing on campus.
- Distance learners in Kindergarten will complete Early Literacy - This is an audio test and they will need to listen and complete on their own. You may read them the directions. This needs to be completed by **Friday, May 14, 2021**. Their teacher can provide you the password and user name if you have forgotten.
- Distance learners in 1st and 2nd grades will complete Early Literacy, STAR Math and STAR Reading
- Distance learners in Grade 1st and 2nd grades will complete Early Literacy, STAR Math and Star Reading. **This needs to be completed Friday, May 14, 2021**. The teacher can provide you with your password and username if you have forgotten.
- Distance learners in 3rd and 4th grades will complete STAR Reading and Math. **This needs to be completed Friday, May 14, 2021**. The teacher can provide you with your password and username if you have forgotten.
- Distance learners in Grades 5 through 8th grade will be taking the STAR testing during school hours, it will be proctored by their teachers. They will receive their passwords from the teachers at the time of testing.

On the computer-adaptive test, all students will encounter questions they do not know the answer to – and it is OK. What is important is that they will give it their best effort.

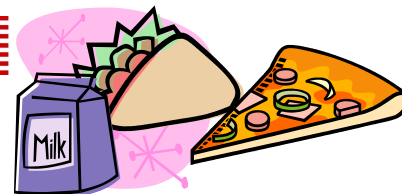
