#### **DROP OFF/PICK UP**

Thank you to the parents who continue to use the front driveway entrance, entering from below, on San Diego Mission Road, for both drop off and pick up. We ask that you try and NOT to use the Rancho Mission Road entrance (above the statue of Jesus), as traffic is backing up and causing a dangerous hazard. Please remember that it is one way only up the hill from San Diego Mission Road. The staff is working hard to temperature check your children and get them to and from class safely.

## STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

Please contact the Nazareth School office 619-641-7987 or office@nazarethschool.org. According to the HHSA, any person with these symptoms must self-isolate for 10 days (stay at home) and may return on day 11.

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (fever defined as a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit that does not resolve within 30 minutes without medication)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Nasal Congestion or runny nose (rhinorrhea)
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor feeding or poor appetite
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19



As we leave for Christmas vacation, I ask you partner with Nazareth School to remain safe from Covid-19. I place a tremendous burden upon you all as a Nazareth Community, and ask that you follow the guidance outlined in our Nazareth School Reopening plan, specifically in regards to traveling and informing Nazareth School of any potential exposure to an individual with COVID-19. Our plan is to return to on-campus instruction on January 4, 2021, yet this may only occur if we work together to keep our community healthy. I have highlighted these specific areas below, and respectfully ask you to re-read and follow these guidance's on our safe school practices.

#### **GUIDANCE IF EXPOSED (pg. 18)**

While we all hope to avoid exposure to illness from COVID19, we need to be prepared for that possibility. If you or someone you've been in contact with has been exposed to the virus, our first concern is for your health and safety and those around you. In this rapidly changing situation, healthcare providers should have the most up-to-date information from the CDC.

Please do the following:

- Quarantine yourself in a specific room away from others in your home
   Contact the following (in order of priority), let them know you have been exposed to COVID19, then follow their instructions.
  - 1. Your healthcare provider
  - 2. Nazareth School's administrator
  - 3. Your supervisor
- 3. Your supervisor will work with HR to determine appropriate next steps.
- 4. In case of an emergency, call 911 and let them know you have been exposed to COVID19, then follow their instructions.

#### TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS (pg. 7)

If a child, household member, teacher or staff member travels to another county or state with widespread community transmission, they must use the following regulations:

- Practice social distancing
- Be alert to symptoms
- Watch for fever, cough, shortness of breath, and other symptoms of COVID-19
- Take temperature if symptoms develop
- Follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop

Nazareth School would appreciate open communication about travel and potential exposure to keep everyone safe during this time.
