Please contact the Nazareth School office 619-641-7987 or office@nazarethschool.org. According to the HHSA, any person with these symptoms must self-isolate for 10 days (stay at home) and may return on day 11.

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (fever defined as a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit that does not resolve within 30 minutes without medication)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Nasal Congestion or runny nose (rhinorrhea)
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor feeding or poor appetite
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

On Monday, I sent out the revised Nazareth Return to School Plan. There are a few significant changes that have been mandated by the state of California. One of the most significant changes has to do with strict travel guidelines. Nazareth School would appreciate open communication about travel and potential exposure to keep everyone safe during this time.

It is as follows:

TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS (pg. 7)

The State of California has updated its travel policy with the following provisions:

Non-essential travel (for recreational purposes) should be limited to 120 miles from the person's home.

With this in mind, please limit recreational travel to no more than 120 miles from your home. If you must travel outside of California or outside of the United States, you will need to quarantine for 10 days upon your return to California.
