#### TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS – UPDATED 2/1/2021

The State of California has updated its travel policy with the following provisions:

- Non-essential travel (for recreational purposes) should be limited to 120 miles from the person's home.
- Californians who travel outside the state or the country must quarantine for 10 days upon their return to California.
- Visitors to California from other states and countries must also quarantine for 10 days upon their entry into California.

With this in mind, please limit recreational travel to no more than 120 miles from your home. If you must travel, you will need to quarantine for 10 days upon your return to California.

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (fever defined as a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit that does not resolve within 30 minutes without medication)

- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue

#### Message from the Holy Father

"Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem" (Mt 20:18). Lent: a Time for Renewing Faith, Hope and Love.

"Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Jesus revealed to his disciples the deepest meaning of his mission when he told them of his passion, death and resurrection, in fulfilment of the Father's will. He then called the disciples to share in this mission for the salvation of the world.

In our Lenten journey towards Easter, let us remember the One who "humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even death on a cross" (*Phil* 2:8). During this season of conversion, let us renew our *faith*, draw from the "living water" of *hope*, and receive with open hearts the *love* of God, who makes us brothers and sisters in Christ. At the Easter vigil, we will renew our baptismal promises and experience rebirth as new men and women by the working of the Holy Spirit. This Lenten journey, like the entire pilgrimage of the Christian life, is even now illumined by the light of the resurrection, which inspires the thoughts, attitudes and decisions of the followers of Christ.

Let us focus on being *compassionate* to others, as we come together as a community, in March, and celebrate this month's core value.

We are very excited to announce that the Chromebooks for 3<sup>rd</sup> though 8<sup>th</sup> grade are ready to be distributed, beginning with 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Please make sure you have signed the Nazareth School Technology Contract for your children's device. A hardcopy went home last week and is posted in your child's Google Classroom. We do require a hard copy to be returned to your child's teacher. If you are a distance learner, please turn in the contract to the school office.

We have chosen not to require a device deposit, understanding the financial difficulties the pandemic has placed on all of our families. Please read the contract CAREFULLY, with your child(ren), so clear expectation on the proper use of technology is established. The Chromebooks will be distributed by class, so we may facilitate an initial whole class training session. The purpose of the Chromebooks is to enable the teachers to integrate educational technology in the classroom and at home. This is a very exciting step for Nazareth School and I look forward to seeing us continue to embrace technology and all it has to offer in a positive curricular environment.

I am looking forward to next week and the opportunity to see you in person during registration. As a reminder, we will be registering in a first come, first serve format, no appointments are necessary from Monday, March 15 through Thursday, March 18<sup>th</sup>, 3:00-5:30pm. If you are unable to register your child(ren) next week, contact the office immediately for an appointment.
