Please contact the Nazareth School office 619-641-7987 or office@nazarethschool.org. According to the HHSA, any person with these symptoms must self-isolate for 10 days (stay at home) and may return on day 11.

- Fever with or without chills/rigors (fever defined as a temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit that does not resolve within 30 minutes without medication)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Nasal Congestion or runny nose (rhinorrhea)
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Poor feeding or poor appetite
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

NAZARETH SCHOOL DISTANCE LEARNING

Nazareth School will be offering distance learning for the entire year, for kindergarten through 8th grade classes, even after Nazareth returns to on campus instruction on September 1st. All classroom instruction will be live streamed, and children will be able to interact with their teacher via Zoom. Google Classroom and See Saw (K-2nd) will continue to be the preferred platform for assigning classwork, and homework.

Communication with our teachers will be the key to a successful year at Nazareth. As parents, you may choose to send your child for in person instruction, or keep them home for distance learning, for a short time or longer. The reality of the situation is students will catch a cold, have a runny nose, or have a sore throat and regardless will need to distance learn for the minimum of ten days before returning to on-campus instruction on day 11.

GRADE – COHORTS:

Kindergarten will use the kindergarten classroom. First grade is in the science lab.

Second grade is in the Second grade classroom.

Third and fourth will be in the Daycare Room

Fifth grade will be in the activities room.

Sixth grade will be in the 6th grade classroom.

Seventh and eighth will be in the computer lab.
