We received late last night clarification on the email regarding cohort maximum sizes of 14 children. It seems the tele-briefing yesterday was not specific and the dioceses misinterpreted the information.

According to the Diocese of San Diego, Head of Office for Schools, John Galvan:

“We received confirmation this evening that today’s CDPH guidance on cohorts refers to day camps and day care. Today’s tele-brief did not make this clear, so we sought clarity.

Gary Johnston, Chief Resilience Officer & County COVID-19 Reopening Lead for San Diego Health & Human Services, confirmed that the new order “is not restraining school classrooms to 14 student cohorts. State guidance on class sizes and physical distancing has not changed.”

We apologize for any confusion this may have created. We are doing our best to provide (and confirm) news and updates as we receive it.”
